Foreword

At T-Mobile, our commitment to performance, innovation, and responsible leadership defines how we operate—and how we engage in the political process. As we reflect on a landmark year in 2024, marked by strong financial results, continued network leadership, and a deepened focus on our customers and communities, we are pleased to share this Political Contributions Report as part of our broader commitment to transparency and good governance.

In 2024, T-Mobile delivered another year of industry-leading performance. We grew our total customer base to 129.5 million, achieved 3.1 million postpaid net account additions, reinforced our position as the undisputed 5G leader, and generated total revenues of over \$66 billion, reflecting the strength of our business model, disciplined execution, and Un-carrier ideals. These results underscore our ability to consistently deliver value to shareholders while continuing to provide the best network, best value, and best experience for our customers.

We recognize that thoughtful engagement in the public policy arena is essential to maintaining a healthy, competitive environment for innovation and investment. Our approach to political contributions is grounded in strategic alignment, compliance, and transparency. T-Mobile engages in the political process through corporate political contributions, employee political action committee (PAC) contributions, lobbying, contributions to tax-exempt organizations, and memberships in trade associations and coalitions. We look to align ourselves with candidates and organizations that share our vision of fostering access, choice, and advancement through technology.

This report outlines our political contributions completed in 2024, including expenditures from our political action committee, corporate dollars where applicable by law and other independent expenditures. Memberships in issue advocacy organizations and trade associations are also noted. The report links to our [federal lobbying reports](#) and includes groups that use a portion of our contributions to lobby. Past support for a candidate or an organization does not entail current or future support. All contributions are made in accordance with applicable laws and guided by our internal governance framework, which emphasizes integrity, accountability, and alignment with long-term business objectives. Corporate and political action committee contributions are bipartisan and transparent, and all transactions are vetted and approved by the Vice President of Legislative Affairs.

As a company that leads with purpose and performs with discipline, we understand the importance of trust—in our brand, in our leadership, and in the way we participate in the democratic process. We are compliant with local, state, and federal laws; our political contributions are bipartisan in nature; and we strictly adhere to our Code of Business Conduct and our [Corporate Responsibility Report](#).

We strive to act as a force for good in public policy by:

- Supporting efforts to make additional wireless spectrum available, enabling continued 5G leadership and network innovation;
- Advocating for modernized spectrum frameworks that unlock new services and promote sustained technological advancement;
- Encouraging tax and fiscal policies that create a stable environment for investment in infrastructure, jobs, and innovation;
- Promoting policies that expand reliable and affordable broadband to unserved and underserved populations across the country; and
- Working to ensure a level playing field and fair competition in the public safety communications sector.

We remain committed to transparency and principled engagement as we advocate for policies that enable continued growth, innovation, and opportunity for all.

Political Giving and Advocacy

T-Mobile engages in political giving as part of our broader responsibility to advocate for policies that support our business, employees, and customers. We take a balanced, bipartisan approach to giving at both the state and federal levels where permissible by law. We consider political contributions—through our PAC or through direct corporate contributions—when candidates meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Demonstrates strong leadership or hold key positions on committees important to our business goals
- Supports public policies that align with our business issues
- Represents areas where many of our employees live and work
- Open to learning more about the issues that impact our work

Our giving is intentionally bipartisan, with support going to both Democratic and Republican candidates and committees. T-Mobile does not contribute to super PACs or ballot initiatives.

We never make contributions based on party affiliation, personal political views, or in exchange for political favors. Decisions are made independently of any individual executive's political preferences. Our focus is on supporting thoughtful leadership that helps drive our business forward and serves the communities where we operate.

Political Action Committee (PAC)

T-PAC is T-Mobile's federal political action committee. It's funded entirely by voluntary contributions from eligible employees—not by the company. Why? Because federal law doesn't allow corporate dollars to go directly to federal candidates. T-PAC gives our employees a way to legally and collectively support candidates who shape the policies that impact our business, industry and future.

As the Un-carrier, we're all about making voices heard—and T-PAC is one more way we do that. It helps connect everyday donors with leaders who make decisions on issues that matter to our business, our customers, and the communities we serve. Through T-PAC, employees have a platform to help build a more connected, inclusive, and forward-thinking future.

State Political Giving

While federal law bars direct corporate contributions to federal candidates, some states allow these funds to be used for state and local races. When permitted by law, and when aligned with our business priorities, T-Mobile may contribute directly to candidates running for state office.

Every contribution is carefully reviewed and approved by our Vice President of Legislative Affairs. We report every donation in full compliance with all laws and limits. In short: We give where it makes sense—and always in the right way.

This report includes all state-level political contributions made in 2024.

Trade Associations and Other Tax-Exempt Organizations

T-Mobile works with trade associations, coalitions, and other tax-exempt organizations to help move the industry forward. These groups bring companies together to speak with one voice on issues that affect us all—from network access to consumer protection to the future of wireless technology.

Some of these organizations also support candidates through their own PACs. While we may share common goals, our participation in these groups doesn't mean we always agree—and it doesn't impact our independence as a competitor. We collaborate where it counts, but we stay true to our own values and strategy.

This report includes 501(c)(4) and 501(c)(6) organizations like trade associations and coalitions where our support exceeds \$25,000 annually.

Lobbying

Building strong connections—with customers and policymakers—is core to who we are. Lobbying allows us to share the T-Mobile story, explain how our work impacts lives, and push for policies that help everyone stay connected.

Our government affairs teams work directly with lawmakers at the state and federal level. We also partner with outside experts when needed. These relationships help ensure the voices of our customers, employees, and business are part of the conversation as laws and policies are shaped.

And like everything we do, we do it the right way. T-Mobile follows all federal and state lobbying laws, including registration and reporting requirements.
