

Privacy Policy

TeraWulf (“The Company” or “we,” “us,” or “our”) respects your privacy, and we are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy (the “Privacy Policy”), as well as any applicable laws, standards, and regulations governing our collection and use of personal data. We want to be transparent with you regarding the information we collect, how we use and share it, and the controls we give you to access, update, and delete your information. This Privacy Policy sets forth TeraWulf’s information collection and use practices for data collected online at any TeraWulf website (each a “Site”). It does not apply to information collected in connection with our offline activities or to information you provide to third parties, including through any application or content that may link to or be accessible from our website. This policy may change from time to time. Your continued use of the Sites after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the Privacy Policy periodically for updates. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, do not use the Sites or otherwise provide us with your personal information. By using any of the Sites, you are acknowledging that that you have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by the Privacy Policy.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

You may view the Sites without providing any personal information—such as your name, address, or date of birth— that, alone or in combination with other information, could reasonably be used to identify you.

We only collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us through the Sites. You may also request information about us through the “contact us” and “careers” sections of the Sites. When you provide personal information to us via this or any other means, we will use this information to respond to your requests and inquiries regarding our products and our business operations, including employment opportunities with TeraWulf. We may also use your personal information to send you information about products and services that we think may interest you.

Generally, we do not share the personal information collected through the Sites with third parties unless we have obtained your prior permission. However, we may share this information under the following circumstances without prior notice or permission: (i) with our business affiliates; (ii) with agents and contractors that assist us in administering the Sites and in providing our products and services to you; (iii) in response to legal process or when we believe in good faith that the law requires it (for example, in response to a court order, subpoena or a law enforcement agency’s request); (iv) to protect the rights, property or safety of TeraWulf, the Sites, users of the Sites and others; or (v) in connection with a transfer or sale of assets or ownership to another entity.

We do not consider the questions, comments, ideas or suggestions you submit to us through the Sites to be personal information. By visiting the Sites, you understand that we may use any information you transmit to us, subject to applicable law, for any purpose, including reproduction, disclosure, transmission, publication, broadcast and posting.

TeraWulf also collects and uses certain non-personal information in anonymous and/or aggregate form to track data such as the total number of visits to our Sites and the number of visitors to each page of our Sites. We use this information to understand how visitors use the Sites so that we may improve them. We may also share this anonymous and/or aggregate information with our affiliates and third parties. This data may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit sites, operating system, date stamp and clickstream data. TeraWulf uses this information, which does not identify individual users, to analyze trends, administer the Sites, track users' movements around the Sites and gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We do not link this automatically-collected data to personally identifiable information.

Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Cookies are small pieces of data, stored in text files, that are stored on your computer or other device when you load websites in a browser. Cookies are widely used to "remember" you and your preferences, either for a single visit ("session cookie") or for multiple repeat visits (using a "persistent cookie"). While we currently do not use cookies on our Sites, we may decide to use them in the future. In the event we do decide to use cookies on any Site, we may do so for a number of purposes, such as maintaining continuity during a user session, to gather data about the usage of our Sites for research and other purposes and to enable our servers to recognize your computer so that your preferences and/or authentication credentials can be recognized so that you do not have to provide this information every time you return to our Sites. You can decide if and how your computer will accept a cookie by configuring your preferences or options in your browser. However, if you choose to reject cookies, you may not be able to use certain of our Sites' features. We may occasionally use other companies to set cookies on our Sites and gather cookie information for us. In some cases we may also use another a TeraWulf affiliate to operate web servers for our Sites. We will use the cookie information gathered by these companies in the same manner as stated above.

TeraWulf also employs clear gifs (a/k/a web beacons/web bugs), that help us better manage content on the Sites. Clear gifs are similar in nature to cookies. Clear gifs are tiny graphics with a unique identifier that are used to track the online movements of visitors to the Sites. In contrast to cookies, which are stored on a user's computer hard drive, clear gifs are embedded invisibly on web pages and are about the size of the period at the end of this sentence. We do not link the information gathered by clear gifs to any personally identifiable information.

Links to Third-Party Websites

TeraWulf may place hypertext links on the Sites that connect to third party websites. TeraWulf has no control over these linked sites or their content. Your use of such linked sites will be subject to such sites' terms of use and privacy policies and not TeraWulf's, so be sure to read them before using such sites or transmitting any information to such sites.

Measures Taken to Secure Your Data

TeraWulf follows generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information submitted to us. No method of electronic storage, however, is 100% secure. Therefore, while we strive to use commercially reasonable means to protect any personal information you submit through the Sites, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Transfers of Personal Information

The hosting facilities for our website and operations are located in the United States. By providing us your data, you consent to its transfer and storage within the U.S.
